LINE CHART

What it is:

A line chart is used to illustrate one or more sets of data over a period of time.

The benefits:

- Simple, easy to use, and interpret. Shows trends.
- Allows for making comparisons of multiple sets of data

The steps:

- 1) Collect the data.
- 2) Draw the time line or sequence scale on the 'x' axis.
- 3) Plot the variable(s) you are measuring on the 'y' axis.
- 4) Interpret the line chart.
